

Privacy policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This privacy policy applies to the www.fenerate.com website and Fenerate Consulting, Inc. (“Fenerate”) and governs all data collection and usage. For the purposes of this privacy policy (“Policy”), unless otherwise noted, all references to Fenerate Consulting, Inc. include www.fenerate.com and Fenerate. The Fenerate website (“Site”) is a news and information site. By using the Fenerate website, you consent to the data practices described in this policy. Please read the policy carefully and keep a copy of it for your reference.

Collection of your personal information

Fenerate may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. We may gather additional personal or nonpersonal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Fenerate. This information may include your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Fenerate website.

Fenerate encourages you to review the privacy policy of websites you choose to link to Fenerate so that you can understand how those websites collect, use, and share your information. Fenerate is not responsible for the privacy policies or other content on websites outside of the Fenerate website.

Use of our personal information

Fenerate collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

Fenerate may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Fenerate and its affiliates.

Fenerate may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinions about current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Fenerate does not sell, rent, or lease its customer lists to third parties.

Fenerate may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you e-mail or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Fenerate, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Fenerate may keep track of the website(s) and page(s) our users visit within Fenerate to determine what Fenerate services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Fenerate to customers whose behaviors indicate that they are interested in particular subject areas.

Fenerate will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to achieve the following: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with a legal process served on Fenerate or the site, (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Fenerate, or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Fenerate or the public.

Use of cookies

The Fenerate website may use “cookies” to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a Web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenient feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the webserver that you have

returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Fenerate pages or register with the Fenerate site or services, a cookie helps Fenerate recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Fenerate website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Fenerate features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Fenerate services or website you visit.

Security of your personal information

To secure your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure, Fenerate uses the following:

Use of Google reCAPTCHA

When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) protocol.

Children under thirteen

Fenerate does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.
